



**Welcome to *The Monocle Centre for the Arts*'
SUPERHERO SUMMER CAMP**

Campers aged 7-12 are invited to spend a week at *The Monocle Centre for the Arts*, a brand-new arts facility in Downtown Peterborough, and participate in our SUPERHERO SUMMER CAMP! Kids will work together to create a one-of-a-kind comic book starring characters of their own creation! Through illustration, costume design, photography, voice over, soundtrack and creative writing, our campers will set their imaginations free and explore what makes them SUPER!

How to Register:

- ◆ Download the registration package, print, fill out and return the last page to us by email (info@themonoclecentreforthearts.com)
- ◆ Camp will be held from Monday August 22 - Friday August 26, from 9am-3pm daily
- ◆ Camp tuition is \$220+HST. (This fee includes a tote bag with camp supplies!)
- ◆ Register a friend or family member and receive a \$10 discount per child
- ◆ Cancellations will be subject to a cancellation fee
- ◆ Parents are invited to The Monocle Centre at 1:30pm on Friday afternoon where they will get to see all of the art created on exhibit as well as a special presentation by the entire camp!

What should I bring to camp?

- ✓ Comfortable shoes and clothing that allows for lots of movement
- ✓ Peanut free lunch, two snacks and refillable drink bottle. Label your containers!
Lunches which do not require refrigeration are preferred.
- ✓ An apron or oversized shirt for painting or messy crafts
- ✓ A positive, friendly attitude and willingness to try new things!

What should I not bring to camp?

- ✓ No phones, iPods etc. allowed
- ✓ No toy weapons (including water pistols) allowed
- ✓ No live animals in Top Hats and/or Monocles (despite what the poster may suggest)

The Monocle Integrated Arts Summer Camp will provide each camper with a tote bag filled with camp supplies. Campers get to take their tote bag, along with any art they create throughout the week, home with them on the last day of camp!



Camper Health and Information Form

The camper health and information form helps us to provide the best possible care for your child. Please fill it out completely. Please pay special attention in providing information in regards to matters of health and safety, so as to provide camp staff with sufficient notice thereof. Please do not hesitate to contact us at any time before or during camp to discuss your child's needs.

Medication at Camp

Please note that staff will only administer medication in its original container and bearing a current prescription label with your child's name on it, so please be sure to document on the camper health and information form any prescription medications your child will require while at camp. When a unit of measurement is required, a labeled dosage implement must be supplied with the medication. Staff cannot accept over-the-counter medication unless prescribed by a physician. Epi-pens and asthma inhalers must be sent daily.

Regarding Accessibility

While we invite campers of any ability to participate, *The Monocle Centre for the Arts* is located on the second and third floor of an older downtown building accessible only by stairs. We sincerely apologize to any campers who may not be able to attend camp because of this limitation.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedure:

The safety of our campers is our first priority. Please observe the following Drop-Off/Pick-Up policy:

- ◆ Entrance is at 140 Simcoe St. (Upper) Look for the Top Hat and Monocle!
- ◆ Please accompany your child into the building on the first day to check in with our camp staff and confirm arrangements for the rest of the week with our camp staff
- ◆ All Campers must be dropped off and picked up each day by someone on your approved list (campers will not be allowed to leave with anyone who is not listed on your camper form)
- ◆ Drop off time is 8:30am - 9:00am
- ◆ Pick up time is 3:00pm (3:30pm at the latest)
- ◆ If you must pick up / drop off outside the allotted time please inquire to see if arrangements can be made (additional fees will apply for special accommodations)
- ◆ Please call Vicky at **705-875-5442** if your child will need to miss camp for any reason. Our staff will call home to check in any time a child does not arrive to camp by 9:30 am without prior notice of their absence
